Students Assistance and Award Sub-Committee

Due to the difficult situation of pandemic and lockdown, the activities of the committee were limited to few events as is the case in most of the areas. However we have made efforts to reach to our students to assist them to the best of our ability in this difficult time. Like most of the cases, activities were mostly limited to a few scholarship award disbursement events and also arrangements are made to facilitate future disbursement.

Few activities carried out in this regard during the above period are mentioned below.

1) Stipend Disbursement:

Stipend from donations from individuals or from few organisations as deposited in favour of 'Student assistance program' are disbursed among selected students based on merit cum means to help them continue their study.

a) Under this scheme in 2020-2021 , a total sum of Rs. 662750 payments for stipend to 309 Nos earlier selected students has been disbursed for the 3rd quarter for the academic year 2020-2021.

b) Further under this scheme , selection of 107 fresh students has been completed by virtual interviews . Approval of the payment is obtained from EC. Disbursement of stipend for these new students will be done shortly.

2) Medal Disbursement :

a) Like every year the student assistance subcommittee worked in collaboration with the JU Controller of Examiner and selected 78 students for the year 2018-2019 toppers for the first three years from all disciplines for the Recipient of Gold plated silver.medals. Due to unavoidable circumstances this award ceremony was postponed from the scheduled date 11.12.2021 and organized on 23.12.2021.

b) Controller of examination is requested to provide a list of toppers for all the disciplines for the academic year 2019-2020. Upon receipt the list. Student assistance subcommittee very recently has organised an award ceremony to hand over the Gold plated medals to the toppers. Few photographs are also given here.

3) Renewal of Stipends :

Activities of renewal of stipends for the academic year 2021-2022 is being undertaken for selection of students and consequently invitation of application is scheduled at the end of December 2021.

4) Scholarship under AEI donation.

Finalised the selection of 109 students for disbursement of AEI Scholarship for the academic year 2020- 2021 for Rs 650 per month per student as promised by AEI. AEI has been requested to continue their financial assistance to these needy and meritorious students for their full academic period till 2023-24. We are awaiting the final approval from AEI on this matter.

Considering the delay in payment from AEI for the academic period 2020 -21 and to mitigate the hardship of the students , JUAA student subcommittee decided to disburse one month's stipend ie a total sum of 70850 distributed among all 109 AEI Sponsored students from JUAA account immediately.

5) Assistance to outgoing students :

The student Assistance subcommittee took an initiative to conduct a Spoken English and Interview technique course to the outgoing students. Due to the current Pandemic

situation such initiative could not be started and is postponed till March 2022.

Cultural Sub-Committee

This year it was held on 16th October, exactly on Ekadoshi of the Durga Puja, thereby fulfilling its naming to the fullest. As the JU campus was closed this year, Football Ekadoshi was held this year at Ramgarh Pragati Sangha football ground, in Gangulybagan Jadavpur, under the strict vigil of the organising committee. Abiding by the Covid norms, not more than 50 persons were allowed inside the pitch at any time of the day and the audience was also split in groups to ensure no gathering happens. The full day was brilliantly managed by the organising committee, lead by the newly formed Sports Sub Committee of JU Alumni Association. From this year onwards, Football Ekadoshi will be a permanent event in the JUAA calendar and will be held under the purview of the Sports Sub Committee.

Every member had fun playing football or watching games and reminiscing the glorious days spent in the university with friends, games and good food. Overall, every member present went home cherishing the day's memories for another year, before the next one comes around and spreads the same happiness.

Auditorium Sub-Committee

We are at present reeling under severe financial crises in view of the prevailing pandemic situation as a result of which generation of revenue has come to a total standstill. In spite of this we have planned to execute the following jobs necessary for the upkeep of the Auditorium as well as improve other facilities on an urgent basis. :-

- 1) Replacement of the Fibre glass sheet of the Foyer
- 2) Treatment of the Roof of the Auditorium
- 3) Overhauling of the Main Curtain System of the stage
- 4) Modification of the Electrical Systems
- 5) Repairing of the Chair in the Auditorium.
- 6) Repair of the Voltas make 17 Tr AC
- 7) Sanitization of the audience before entrance through automatic sanitizer equipment.

We are expecting to execute all the above jobs very soon and be ready with a fully prepared auditorium.

We are glad to share that we have renewed the Annual Maintenance Contracts with Voltas and Flash Point for AC and Fire system of the hall respectively even under this difficult situation.

Social Sub-Committee

As soon as the first wave of Covid -19 virus came to its low .. From Centenary Celebration Desk

The Centenary Organising Committee was formed during mid 2019 consisting of total thirty-two members with Sri Aloke Mookherjee – Chairperson, Sri Hiren K Ghosh- Co-Chairperson, Smt Sati Chatterjee – Co-Chairperson and Sri Prabir Choudhury as the Organising Secretary. A year-long centenary programme was prepared for our association from January 2020 to January 2021.

A press briefing and a curtain raiser program was successfully organized on 19th September 2019 at our Dr Triguna Sen Auditorium. The inaugural function was held on 8th January 2020 at Vivekananda Hall of Ramakrishna Mission Institute of Culture, Golpark. Hon'ble Governor of West Bengal was present as chief guest.

On this occasion, Sri Anupam Roy, famous musician and also our alumnus, composed and sang a centenary theme song based on a beautiful poem written by Smt Purabi Bhattacharyya published in the centenary commemorative volume. Both the song and the commemorative volume were released on the same day.

A national seminar on “Conventional to renewable power” was also arranged on 7th February 2020. Next day we also had Prof. Gopal Chandra Sen memorial lecture, followed by a dance drama performed by an invited group on 8th February 2020. Venue for both the days was Dr. Triguna Sen auditorium.

We regret to inform that our total year-long centenary program was completely jeopardized with effect from end of March 2020 due to the unprecedented Covid-19 pandemic situation resulting in cancellation of all scheduled programs till date.

However, in association with JU, we could successfully organise a “Gold Medal” award for “Best Sports Girl Student” of JU in every year – a part of our centenary programs.

We have also paid a token one-time ex-gratia payment to all our ten office staffs in recognition of their good work in the centenary activities.

We have already installed two metal plates, containing the names of all the Presidents and Secretaries of our association from 1921 to 2021 in the foyer of the alumni building – a part of centenary programs.

It is now finally resolved that the tenure of Centenary Organising Committee is extended to 31st March 2022 when this committee will submit an Income / Expenditure financial report to the parent body before final closure of the centenary celebration and dissolution of the committee.

It has been proposed by our Chairperson to schedule the Closing Ceremony in a befitting manner before 31st March 2022 through a cultural program, followed by a hi-tea or centenary dinner if situation permits.

Regarding the installation of Bio-Composter at JU main hostel, as the project is not possible in near future in the given situation, we had no other way but to give up the same. As few members had donated money specifically for this project, they should be approached with an appeal whether the concerned donors would agree to transfer their funds to any other account of the Alumni Association or any other option they deem fit.

In the present scenario, COC has decided to organise at least two scheduled programs within the 31st March 2022 time frame. Namely (a) a musical program “Kurnish”, scripted by our beloved alumnus late Asutosh Deb as a tribute to the covid warriors. It will be staged on 19th February 2022 at 5:30 pm. Regular rehearsal has already been started on the above musical programme under the guidance of Smt Purabi Bhattacharyya, Sri Swapan Naskar and Smt Mita Mukherjee. And (b) a good Closing Ceremony followed by hi-tea / dinner around third week of

March 2022. Venue for both the programs will be our auditorium.

The remaining pending programs such as (1) installation of a lift in the Alumni building, (2) creation of a membership directory, (3) felicitation of senior teachers of JU (80+ years) and (4) a cultural programs by Alumni members will be taken up in April 2022 onwards by new task forces to be formed for this purpose by present office bearers in due course.

Latest Updates

In view of the resignation of Sri Alope Mookherjee as Chairperson COC, due to his personal reasons, Sri Rasendu Putatunda was unanimously selected as new chairperson of COC.

By virtue of the elected post of alumni association, Sri Bimal Ghosh as President, Dr. Saibal Chakrabarty as Secretary, Sri Manisha Choudhury as Joint Secretary and Smt Purabi Bhattacharya as Treasurer, they will be now new Co-Chairperson, Joint Secretaries and Treasurers of the COC respectively.

We were extremely happy to hear from our Chairperson that Smt Ratnabali Chakraborty w/o late Samaresh Chakraborty who was a member of Alumni (Chemical Engg. 1964) has given her consent to utilise Rs 10 lac towards the installation of the lift which donated by her in the memory of her late husband.
