Auditorium & Seminar Room Subcommittee

During the last quarter our subcommittee has carried out some important civil works such as....

- 1) Painting of Rooms in first floor.
- 2) Fixing of vitrified tiles in the corridor of first floor.
- 3) Face lifting of men's urinal & terminal in the first floor.

Apart from the above civil works the seminar room is also totally renovated now.

Guesthouse Subcommittee

It was already decided to take up the renovation work and facelift the rooms to attract more guests. Face lifting of the Guest Rooms with new bed sheets, towel, curtain, pillow covers etc. is now completed. Total 20000.00 is incurred in two phases for this purpose.

The above initiatives have given us positive results and we have seen a distinct increase in the occupancy rate from last year's 300 plus to 500 plus this year.

Memorial & Seminar Subcommittee

Our Memorial & Seminar Subcommittee began this year activities with two pending webinars from previous year. It was a series of two consecutive webinars with the title – “Hungry Tide” part I and part II. On 19 April, Hungry Tide – Part I was conducted through a lecture – **“Fading Lands, Moving People: A Saga of Sundarbans”** by Professor Sugata Hazra , Ex- Director of School of Oceanographic Studies , JU. It was followed by “Hungry Tide” part II on 26 April with a lecture – **“The Environmental Realities and Social Life in The Sundarbans”** by Professor Amitesh Mukhopadhyay, Department of Sociology, JU. Both the webinars in hybrid mode was very much interesting and highly appreciated by the participants as well as viewers.

On 21 June the team had their third webinar on the origin of Bengali Theatre with the title **“যাত্রা দ্যাখে ফাত্রা লোকে”** a highly interesting and exciting lecture by Professor Sujit Kumar Mandal of Comparative Literature, JU. It was really attractive lecture from a different perspective.
